Turn Over A New Leaf This Fall

There are many factors in play when it comes to helping the environment. Although some changes will require coordination on a global scale, there are a few ways that we can reduce our individual carbon footprint in our day-to-day life. 8. Switch to renewable power at your home with an on-site roof-top solar array or enroll as a subscriber into a community solar garden project.

As of September 1, 2023, the electric supply price to compare to is currently 7.877 cents/kWh (Up to 800 kWh) and 7.877 cents/kWh (Above 800 kWh)¹. The electric utility electric supply price will expire on September 30, 2023. The utility electric supply price to compare does not include the purchased electricity adjustment factor.
