

## Township of Flora Electricity Aggregation Program



After a competitive bidding process, the Township of Flora selected a new provider, MC Squared Energy Services, LLC (mc<sup>2</sup>), to provide electricity supply services to residents and small businesses beginning September 2017. The frequently asked questions below provide additional information regarding the Flora Township program.

### What is electricity aggregation?

On August 10, 2009, Governor Quinn signed into law Public Act 096-0176, which allows governmental bodies to arrange for the provision of electricity to residential and small commercial retail customers by alternative electric suppliers (i.e. suppliers other than ComEd). Under this law, the City may seek bids for the provision of aggregate electricity supply services to their residents and small businesses, in hopes that the selected rate will be lower than the standard published rate offered by ComEd.

### What is the electricity supply price for participating members?

mc<sup>2</sup> Electricity Supply Price

**6.68** cents per kWh

The aggregation supply price is a fixed electric supply price, measured in cents per kWh. It will begin with the first billing cycle your rate change is confirmed with ComEd and continue until September 2020 meter read.

### Who is eligible to participate?

Eligible residential requirements: All residents located in the Township of Flora that are currently with the existing electricity aggregation program or receiving electricity supply service from ComEd are eligible to participate. Eligible customers will be automatically enrolled unless they take action to Opt-Out.

Eligible business requirements: All small businesses located in the Township of Flora that are currently with the existing electricity aggregation program or receiving electricity supply service from ComEd and have annual usage of 15,000 kWh or less are eligible to participate. Eligible small businesses will be automatically enrolled unless they take action to OptOut.

Opt-In eligible customers: All residents and small businesses (with annual usage of 15,000 kWh or less) located in the Township of Flora that currently receive service under the following programs/rates are eligible to Opt-In to the electricity aggregation program.

- ComEd's Hourly Rate
- Net Metering Program
- Retail Electric Service
- New Residents

To Opt-In to the program, call mc<sup>2</sup> at 1-855-575-9231, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

## What will change on my electricity bill?

You will continue to receive a single bill from ComEd on a monthly basis. mc<sup>2</sup> charges for electricity supply and transmission services will be included in the “Supply” portion of your ComEd bill. ComEd will continue to bill you for distribution services and taxes. Payments should still be sent to ComEd at the address provided by the utility.

## Will I receive confirmation of my switch to mc<sup>2</sup>?

ComEd will mail you a confirmation letter indicating they have received notice of your switch to “MC Squared Energy Services” as your electricity supplier.

## Will my electricity service be disrupted when I switch?

No, there will be no disruption in service. You will continue to receive the same electric service through the same transmission and distribution system currently operated by ComEd. The switch to mc<sup>2</sup> is seamless.

## What if my power goes out – who do I call?

ComEd is responsible for ensuring that electricity flows through its distribution network to all homes and businesses. Being a member of an electricity aggregation program does not change how ComEd responds to outages. ComEd continues to be responsible for the wires, poles, and all emergencies, including outage restoration. All service issues, including power outages, should still be reported to ComEd at 1-800-334-7661.

## Is there an early termination fee?

No. However, you will be obligated to pay for services rendered under the contract until service is terminated.

## What if I have already switched to an Alternative Retail Electricity Supplier (ARES)?

If you have already switched to an Alternative Retail Electricity Supplier (ARES), you can still Opt-In to the program by calling mc<sup>2</sup> at 1-855-575-9231, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. You should check with your current provider to better understand any restrictions or policies that might apply - you may be subject to early termination fees.
